Cream Puff Recipe

1 cup boiling water

½ cup butter or margarine

1 cup flour

½ tsp. salt

4 eggs

Melt butter in boiling water in a medium saucepan, over high heat. Turn heat to low. Add flour and salt all at once, stirring vigorously with spoon until mixture leaves side of pan in a smooth compact mass.

Immediately remove from heat.

Quickly beat in eggs, one at a time, beating until each is blended and mixture is smooth. Continue beating until it forms stiff dough. Drop by heaping tablespoon (it helps to have a wet spoon) 2" apart on cookie sheet, shaping with wet spoon into rounds which point up in center.

Bake in hot oven of 450° for 10 minutes, then 400° for 20-25 minutes. The Puffs should be puffed high and golden brown.

Remove with spatula to wire rack and cool.

Split puff and fill with filling.

Filling: 1 large cool whip
1 pkg. Instant Vanilla Pudding or
White Chocolate Pudding
1 cup milk

If you want smaller ones use Teaspoon.
Bake for 8 minutes at 450° and 12-15 at 400°.
