## Manatee Show Winners

Here are the results from our display at the Manatee Orchid Show. There are two different ways of judging orchids and orchid exhibits: in one, the entries in a show compete against each other for first, second and third place in each class; in the other, plants and exhibits are independently evaluated against established national standards. The former is show judging. The Manatee Show was the former. There were 9 categories, Small Cat, Large Cats, Dens, Oncidium, Phals, Vandas, Cypripedium (Paphs, etc) , Encyclia and Other. There were first (blue), second (red) and third (yellow) place ribbons awarded in each category. That adds up to 27 ribbons total. Plus a trophy per category. No trophies but—
