## Tip

Now is the time to finish repotting winter blooming Phalaenopsis. If they are all nicely repotted they should be in good shape for the coming blooming season. Be sure to water early in the day so that the leaves will be dry before sundown. Look for them to start spiking in November & December. Flowers in January!
