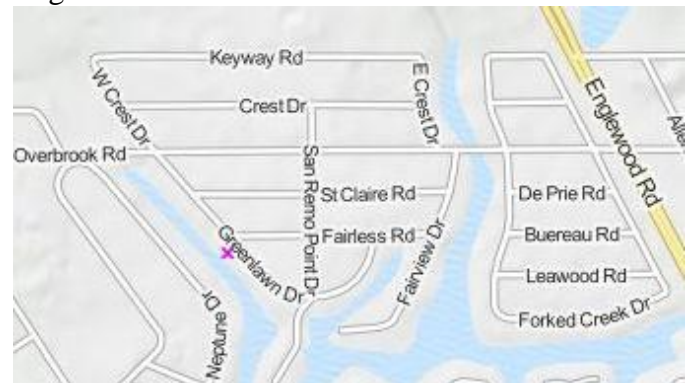
## August Garden Tour
